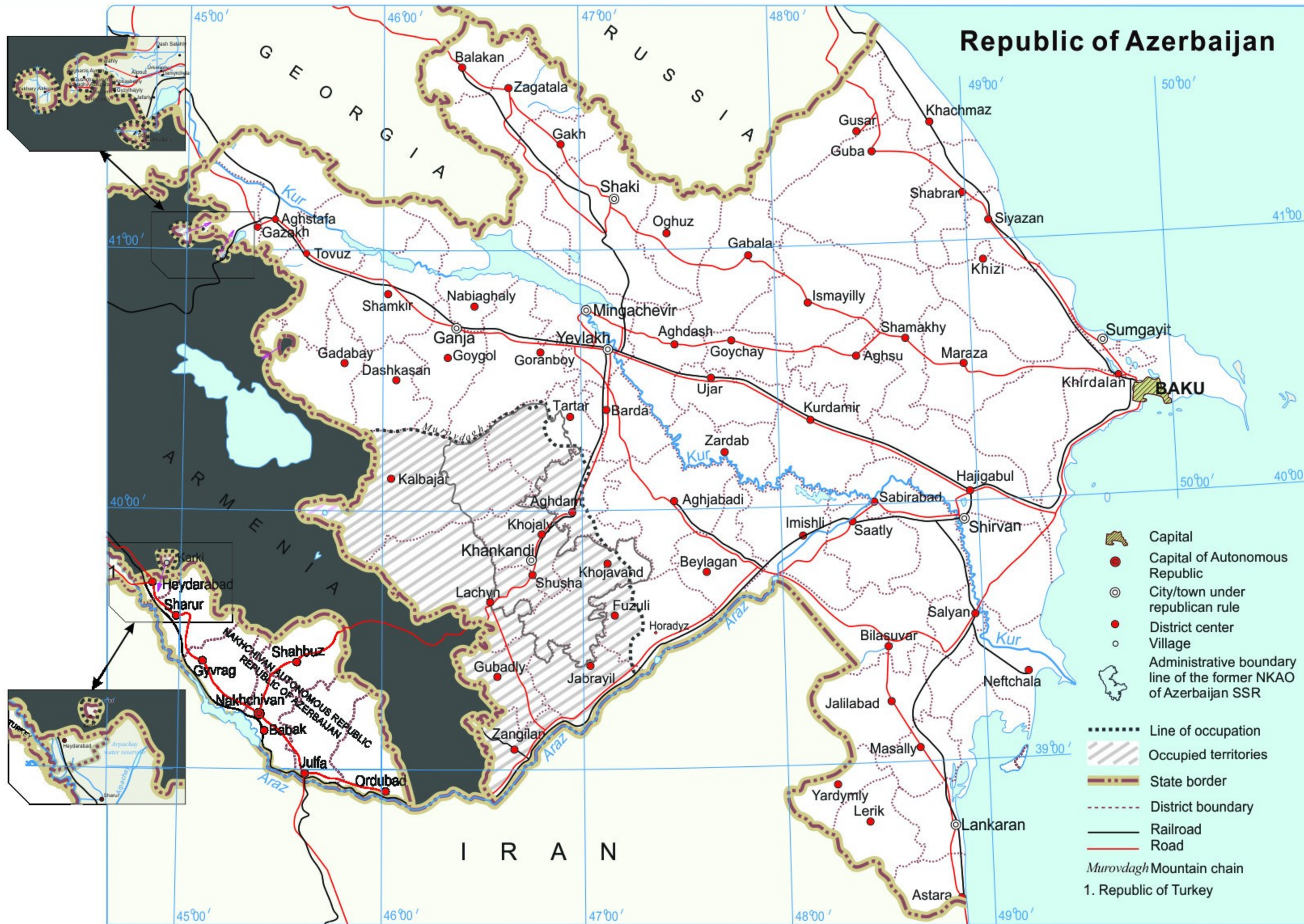


CONSEQUENCES OF THE AGGRESSION OF ARMENIA AGAINST AZERBAIJAN
